Depending upon the size of the Group, this will take place at the Vicarage, 26 Falcon Road, Bingley BD16 4DW or at the Church.

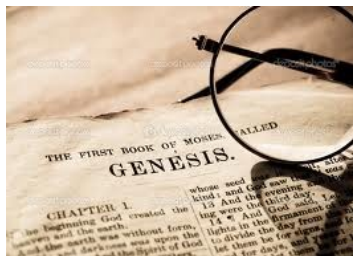
